## Citizenship – Traits, Navigators on a Roll

At the end of each month, teachers will identify students from their class who have exhibited the specified citizenship trait for the month, outstanding academic and work study effort, and excellent attendance. Students will be selected and celebrated based on the guidelines given by the school counselor/administrator. In addition, students will be recognized monthly on the morning show. The names of students selected will be posted on the Navigators on a Roll display in the main hallway.

Teachers are to introduce students to the citizenship traits found in the student agenda book: Responsibility, Respect, Compassion, Honesty, Tolerance, Perseverance, Cooperation, and Self-Discipline. Please reinforce these traits during your daily classroom instruction. Below is our schedule of traits that will be emphasized:

Month	Character Trait	Descriptor
September	Respect	Recognize the value of others' ideas, beliefs, and property
October	Responsibility	Be accountable for your actions
November	Self-Discipline	Control your actions and emotions; set and achieve goals
December	Kindness	Show concern for others through thoughtful actions and words
January	Perseverance	Have courage to pursue your goals no matter how difficult
February	Honesty	Be truthful in what you say and do
March	Courtesy	Use actions and words which are respectful
April	Cooperation	Work with others toward a common goal
May	Fairness	Treat others and their property impartially
